AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LLOYD, MISSOURI, AMENDING SECTION 1.12 OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORIDINANCE TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION FROM SEVEN (7) MEMBERS TO NINE (9) MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2005, the Village of Loch Lloyd has adopted a Unified Development Code and official zoning map for the village for the purpose of regulating and controlling the development of land and related matters within the village and to promote the public safety, health, and general welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Development Code creates a Planning and Zoning Commission pursuant to the statutory requirements of Missouri, which Planning and Zoning Commission is charged with reviewing applications for amendment of the zoning map, consideration of development applications, and making recommendations for the same to the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, Section 1.12(A) of the Unified Development Code identifies the membership of the Planning and Zoning Commission, to consist of seven (7) members including the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, a member of the Board selected by the Board, and five (5) citizens appointed by the Chairman and approved by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has considered increasing the membership of the Planning and Zoning Commission to a total of nine (9) members including the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, a member of the Board selected by the Board, and seven (7) citizens appointed by the Chairman and approved by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LLOYD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 1.12(A) of the Unified Development Code is hereby amended as follows:

- A. <u>Membership</u>. The Zoning Commission is hereby continued and established as the Planning and Zoning Commission. It shall consist of seven (7) nine (9) members including the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, a member of the Board of Trustees selected by the Board, and five (5) seven (7) citizens appointed by the Chairman and approved by the Board of Trustees.
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall be known as the 1st Amendment to the Unified Development Code.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Effective Date. The effective date of approval of this Ordinance shall be coincidental with the Chairman's signature and attestation by the Village Clerk.

Section 4. Severability. If any section	, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase,
or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, h	neld to be invalid or unconstitutional by
any court of competent jurisdiction, such portior	shall be deemed a separate, distinct,
and independent provision, and such holding sha	Il not affect the validity of the remaining
portions thereof.
