ORDINANCE NO.

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LLOYD, MISSOURI CALLING FOR AND ESTABLISHING THE DATE OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 2, 2024.”

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the Village of Loch Lloyd (the “Village”) consists of Trustees who are elected by the qualified voters of the Village to serve for terms of two (2) years, and until their successors are elected and qualified; and

WHEREAS, the terms for two (2) seats on the Board will be open for the general municipal election to be held on April 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Board is seeking to call said election to fill the two (2) seats and to provide notice for filing by any candidate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LLOYD, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. Call for Election. An election is hereby called for the 2nd day of April, 2024 for the purpose of electing two (2) Trustees who shall hold their offices for a term of two (2) years, and until their successors are elected and qualified.

Section 2. Qualified Candidates. Any person duly qualified who desires to seek election shall file with the Village Clerk of Loch Lloyd, Missouri, at any time after 8:00 a.m. on December 5, 2023, and before December 26, 2023, excluding holidays.

Section 3. Instructions to Village Clerk. The Village Clerk is directed to comply with the Comprehensive Election Action of 1977, as amended, and to give notice as required by law.

Section 4. Polls. At the election on the foregoing offices, the qualified registered voters of the Village shall vote at the polling place(s) within the Village, as designated by the Clerk of Cass County.

Section 5. Conduct of Election. The judges and clerks at such election shall be designated by the Clerk of Cass County and said Clerk of Cass County shall conduct the election and cause the results thereof to be certified to the Village Board of Trustees as provided by law.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 7. Effective Date. The effective date of approval shall be coincidental with the Chairman’s signature and attestation from the Village Clerk.
