

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LLOYD, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO ENTER INTO A MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GEORGE BUTLER ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR ON-CALL BUILDING INSPECTION, PLAN REVIEW, AND PERMIT ISSUANCE SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED AND DATED APRIL 18, 2024.”

WHEREAS, at its March 20, 2024 Board meeting, the Village Board of Trustees voted unanimously to identify a qualified entity or individual to provide on-call building inspection, plan review, and permit issuance services to the Village and the Board of Trustees on future construction and development applications; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a submittal by George Butler Associates, Inc., of Lenexa, KS, which comports with the scope of services requested from the March 20, 2024 vote; and

WHEREAS, the Village is inclined to retain the services of George Butler Associates, pursuant to the scope of services, identified including all costs and hourly rates for on-call building inspection, plan review, and permit issuance services.






NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH, LLOYD, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The submission of George Butler Associates, Inc., is hereby accepted and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to enter into the Master Services Agreement presented by George Butler Associates, Inc., for on-call building inspection, plan review, and permit issuance services pursuant to the proposal submitted and dated April 18, 2024.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage and approval and any parts of other Ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
