

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LOYD, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH TREKK DESIGN GROUP, LLC PURSUANT TO THE CONTRACT SUBMITTED AND DATED AUGUST 9, 2024"

WHEREAS, at its February 27, 2024, Board Meeting, the Village Board of Trustees voted unanimously to apply for a cost sharing agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation regarding a potential new traffic signal to be built at the intersection of Route D and Loch Lloyd Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Village, in response to its application for a cost sharing agreement regarding a potential new traffic signal, has received a submitted contract from the TREKK DESIGN GROUP, LLC (the "Consultant") which comports with the scope of services applied for pursuant to the February 27, 2024, vote; and

WHEREAS, the Village is inclined to accept the contract provided by the Consultant pursuant to the scope of services, compensation schedule and responsibilities as detailed in the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH LOYD MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The professional services agreement submitted by the Consultant attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit "A" is hereby accepted and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to enter into the contract as presented by the Consultant for professional services related to the creation of a traffic signal to be built at the intersection of Route D and Loch Lloyd Parkway.


Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage and approval and any parts of other Ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
